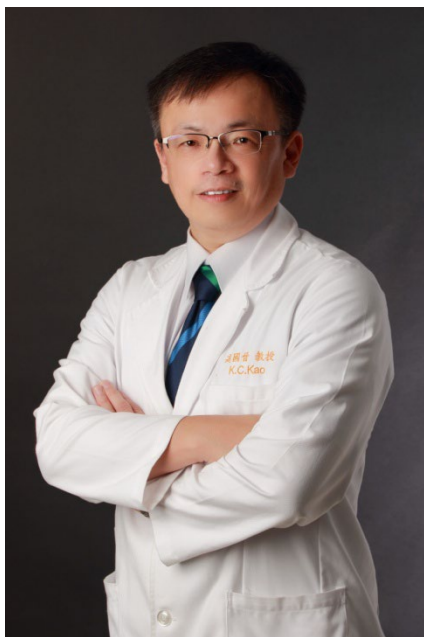

Dr. Kuo-Chin Kao graduated from Taipei Medical University in 1992 with getting MD degree. He was a research fellow of Arthur Slutsky Labortory, University of Toronto since 2001 to 2012. Currently, he is Professor and Deputy Director of Internal Medicine at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, Linkou. Also, he was Deputy Head of Critical Care Medicine, Asia Pacific Society of Respiratory (APSR) Scientific Committee since November 2018. Now, he is the Head of Critical Care Medicine, APSR Scientific Committee since 2021. His interests are focused on the Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome (ARDS) including the Epidemiology, open lung biopsy (OLB), Prone Positioning, Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO), High Frequency Oscillation Ventilation (HFOV) and mechanism of ventilator induced lung injury (VILI) including driving pressure and mechanical power. In addition, he is involved in translational research to investigate new approach for ARDS through a systems medicine method. He also led the Lung Transplantation group in Chang Gung Memorial Hospital since 2016. He currently is the reviewers of several critical care and respiratory journals including Lancet Respiratory Medicine, Critical Care Medicine, Critical Care, Journal of Critical Care, Journal of Thoracic Disease, BMC Anesthesiology, BMC Pulmonary Medicine, Journal of Formosa Medicine Association, Medicine, PLOS ONE and Biomedical Journal. He has authored and co-authored about more than 200 scientific articles, reviews and book chapters.
